

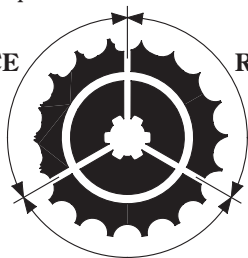
5. Inspect the sprocket teeth for possible wear or damage. Replace if necessary.

6. If the drive chain or sprockets are excessively worn or damaged, they should be replaced. Never use a new chain with worn sprockets; rapid chain wear will result.

7. < Except GR type >

Install the chain covers and tighten the bolts A and bolt B to the specified torque.

Bolts A and bolt B torque:

6 N·m (0.6 kgf·m , 4.4 lbf·ft)
