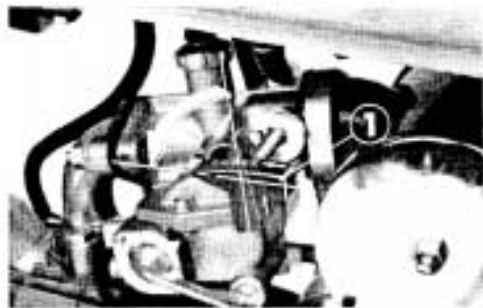


Each time the pedal is raised, the next lower gear in sequence is engaged until the neutral position is reached.

CHOKE HANDLE

Turning the choke handle ① counterclockwise will close the choke to produce a rich fuel mixture for starting the engine when cold. As the engine attains normal

operating temperature, the choke must be opened by turning the choke handle clockwise.

FUEL VALVE

The fuel valve ① (page 10) is mounted on the left side of the carburetor.

“S” position

In this position, the fuel flow will be cut off.

When parking the vehicle, place the fuel valve in the “S” position.

“ON” position

In this position, fuel will flow to the carburetor.

When starting the engine, place the valve in the “ON” position.
