

■ PARKING

CAUTION: When parking the motorcycle, position the ignition switch to the "OFF" position and remove the key. The steering should also be locked. Turn the fuel valve to the "OFF" position. When parking at night near traffic, the ignition switch can be positioned to the "PARKING" position and the key removed (page 12). This will turn on the taillight and make the motorcycle more visible to traffic.

■ SAFE RIDING SUGGESTIONS

1. Always make a PRE-RIDING INSPECTION prior to riding your motorcycle (see page 24).
2. Never ride a motorcycle without a helmet and it is recommended that the motorcyclist wear boots, gloves, eye protection, and bright clothing to further enhance rider safety.
3. Handlebar fairings and luggage racks or saddle bags may adversely affect the handling characteristics of the motorcycle. Extra care must be taken in loading and riding motorcycles with this equipment.
Do not exceed the vehicle load limit shown on the tire information label.
4. Place both hands on the handlebars and your feet on the foot rests while riding. Encourage a passenger to hold himself on the motorcycle with both hands and to use the passenger foot rests.
