## RIGHT HANDLEBAR CONTROLS (Except U)

## **Engine Stop Switch**

The engine stop switch (1) is next to the throttle grip. When the switch is in the  $\bigcap$  (RUN) position, the engine will operate. When the switch is in the  $\bowtie$  (OFF) position, the engine will not operate. This switch is intended primarily as a safety or emergency switch and should normally remain in the  $\bigcap$  (RUN) position.

### **CAUTION:**

# \* Do not operate the engine stop switch unnecessarily while driving.

## **Headlight Switch**

The headlight switch (2) has three positions;  $\Re$ ,  $\Rightarrow$  and OFF marked by a dot to the right of  $\Rightarrow$ .

Headlight, taillight, position light and meter lights on.

Position light, taillight and meter lights on.


OFF (dot): Headlight, taillight, position

light and meter lights off.

#### **Starter Button**

The starter button (3) is below the headlight switch (2).

When the starter button is pressed, the starter motor cranks the engine. If the engine stop switch is in the 🏻 (OFF) position, the starter motor will not operate. See page 55 for the starting procedure.
