## **Engine Oil & Strainer Screen**

5. Pour the drained oil into a suitable container and dispose of it in an approved manner (page 143).

## NOTICE

Improper disposal of drained fluids is harmful to the environment.

- 6. Check the condition of the sealing washer on the engine oil drain bolt.

  Replace the washer every other time the oil is changed.

  Install the engine oil drain bolt and
  - Install the engine oil drain bolt and tighten it to the specified torque:

18 lbf·ft (24 N·m , 2.4 kgf·m)

- 7. Fill the crankcase with the recommended oil (page 91), approximately:
  - 0.6 US qt (0.6 l)

- 8. Install the oil filler cap/dipstick securely.
- 9. Lock the rear wheel (page 24).
- 10. Start the engine and let it idle for 3-5 minutes.
- 11. Stop the engine and wait 2-3 minutes.
- 12. Check that the oil level is at the upper level mark on the oil filler cap/dipstick (page 94).
- 13. Check that there are no oil leaks.

If a torque wrench is not used for installation, see your Honda dealer as soon as possible to verify proper assembly.
