

CAUTION: Never install a new drive chain on badly worn sprockets, or use new sprockets with a badly worn drive chain.

3. Tighten the rear axle nut.
Rear axle nut torque: 80–100 N·m (8.0–10.0 kg-m, 58–72 ft-lb)
4. Recheck chain slack.
5. Rear brake pedal free play is affected when repositioning the rear wheel to adjust drive chain slack.
Check rear brake pedal free play and adjust as necessary (page 122).
