## Spray Cleaning Your ATV

Refer to *Safety Precautions* on page 85.

Avoid using spray cleaner products on the tires or suspension components.

Suggestions for using spray cleaner(s) follow:

| <b>ATV condition</b>                   | <b>Recommended Cleaning</b>  |
|--|--|
| Dust and fingerprint smudges.          | Apply a spray cleaner/polish and wipe paint, chrome, glass, and clear plastic.   |
| Light road grimes.                     | Spray any difficult-to-reach or very dirty areas with a spray cleaner/degreaser.<br>Rinse and dry.<br>Apply a spray cleaner/polish and wipe with a non-abrasive cloth. |
| Heavy grime. Oil leaks.<br>Brake dust. | Use a spray cleaner/degreaser. If necessary, rub with a sponge.<br>Rinse and dry.<br>Apply a spray cleaner/polish and wipe with a non-abrasive cloth.                  |
| Dull, corroded chrome or aluminum.     | Apply a high quality chrome/aluminum polish and wipe with a non-abrasive cloth.  |
