## Starting Procedure (After Preparation)

To restart a warm engine, follow the procedure for High Air Temperature.

The starter motor will operate only when the transmission is in neutral.

## Normal Air Temperature

- Move the choke lever (1) left to the fully ON (A) position, if the engine is cold.
- 2. With the throttle closed, press the starter button.

## CAUTION:

\* Pressing the electric starter button for more than 5 seconds at a time may cause the starter to overheat and damage the starter. Release the starter button for approximately 10 seconds before pressing it again.




Fig. 3-9 (1) Choke lever (A) Fully ON (B) Fully OFF

- 3. Immediately after the engine starts, operate the choke lever to keep fast idle.
- Continue warming up the engine until it runs smoothly and responds to the throttle with the choke lever in the fully OFF (B) position.
- 5. If idling is unstable, open the throttle slightly.
