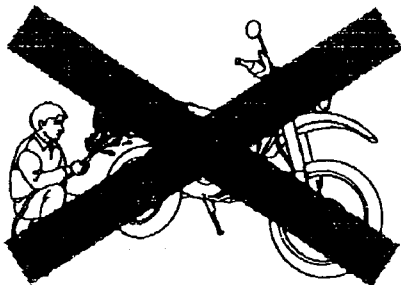


## Caring for your motorcycle

- When washing your motorcycle, do not allow water to run into the muffler. Water inside the muffler may cause starting trouble and build up rust inside the muffler.
- Keep brake parts dry when washing. Wet brakes have reduced braking performance. After washing your motorcycle, drive slowly, in a safe area and check the brake function. If the braking performance is found to be poor, apply light braking while riding slowly in order to dry the brake discs/pads.



- When waxing the motorcycle, Do not rub the painted or plastic surfaces too hard. The painted/top coated surface may scratch or become thin and may have uneven colour.
