
Lubricating and cleaning the drive chain

Remove dirt and mud on the drive chain and sprockets by using a brush. Move the motorcycle back and forward to clean the entire chain and both sprockets. Do not steam-clean the chain as it may cause damage to the Rubber o-rings.

After cleaning all dirt from the chain, apply lubrication along its surface. Apply from both sides of the chain rollers. Excessive lubrication may splash onto your clothing or the motorcycle itself.

Recommended lubrication:

Genuine Honda chain oil or gear oil #80 - #90

Or equivalent.

Tip:

Some non-Honda chain oil, including chain spray, may contain additives, which may reduce the chain life.
