Spark Plugs

- 5. Discard the spark plugs.
- 6. With the plug washers attached, install the spark plugs in by hand to prevent cross-threading.
- 7. Tighten each spark plug:
 - If the old plug is good:

1/8 turn after it seats.

- If installing a new plug, tighten it twice to prevent loosening:
 - a) First, tighten the plug:

NGK: 3/4 turn after it seats.

DENSO: 1/2 turn after it seats.

- b) Then loosen the plug.
- c) Next, tighten the plug again: 1/8 turn after it seats.

NOTICE

An improperly tightened spark plug can damage the engine. If a plug is too loose, a piston may be damaged. If a plug is too tight, the threads may be damaged.

- 8. Reinstall the spark plug caps. Take care to avoid pinching any cables or wires.
- 9. Reinstall the left and right cylinder head side covers.
