
## If a Fuse Blows

Main Fuse Access

## INSIDE THE BATTERY COVER



- 1. To prevent an accidental short circuit, turn the ignition switch OFF (w) before checking or replacing the fuse.
- 2. To access the main fuse (1), remove the battery cover (page 156).
- 3. Remove the fuse case cover (2).
- 4. Pull the main fuse out.

  If it is blown, install the spare main fuse (3).

If you do not have a replacement fuse with the proper rating for the circuit, install one with a lower rating.

## **NOTICE**

Replacing a fuse with one that has a higher rating greatly increases the chance of damage to the electrical system.

- 5. Reinstall the fuse case cover.
- 6. Install the battery cover.

If the replacement fuse of the same rating burns out in a short time, there is probably a serious electrical problem on your ATV. Leave the blown fuse in that circuit and have your ATV checked by your dealer.
