## Is Your ATV Ready to Ride?

Tires Use a gauge to check the air pressure. Adjust if

needed. Also look for signs of damage or

excessive wear (page 156).

Drivetrain Boots Check for damage (page 161).

Guards Check for damage (page 160).

Nuts & Bolts Check the wheels to see that the axle nuts are

tightened. Use a wrench to make sure all accessible nuts, bolts, and fasteners are tight.

Underbody & Check for, and remove, any dirt, vegetation or

Exhaust System other debris that could be a fire hazard or

interfere with the proper operation of the

vehicle.

Air Cleaner Housing Check for deposits in the drain tube. If

Drain Tube necessary, clean the tube (page 128) and check

the air cleaner housing.

Leaks, Loose Parts Walk around your ATV and look for anything

that appears unusual, such as a leak or loose

cable.

Cable Check the cable housings for wear. Check the

fittings for looseness. Replace or tighten as

needed.

Lights Make sure the headlight, brakelight and

taillight are working properly.

If you are carrying cargo, also check the following:

Loading Limits Make sure you do not exceed the load limits

(page 55).
