
Brakes

Adjustment

- Adjust by turning the rear brake adjusting nut (4) a half-turn at a time.
 Make sure the cut-out on the adjusting nut is seated on the brake arm pin (5).
- Apply the brake, release it, and then spin the wheel and check that it rotates freely. Repeat this procedure several times.
- 3. Check the freeplay. If you can't adjust the freeplay properly, see your dealer.
