

## Pre-ride Inspection

To ensure safety, it is your responsibility to perform a pre-ride inspection and make sure that any problem you find is corrected. A pre-ride inspection is a must, not only for safety, but because having a breakdown, or even a flat tyre, can be a major inconvenience.

Check the following items before you get on your motorcycle:

- Fuel level-Fill fuel tank when necessary. ➤ P. 32
- Throttle-Check for smooth opening and full closing in all steering positions. ➤ P. 79
- Engine oil level-Add engine oil if necessary. Check for leaks. ➤ P. 58
- Drive chain-Check condition and slack, adjust and lubricate if necessary. ➤ P. 72

- Brakes-Check operation;

Front and Rear: check shoes wear (➤ P. 68) and freeplay, adjust if necessary.

➤ P. 63, 66

**Except XL125LEK**

Front: check brake fluid level (➤ P. 61) and pads wear. ➤ P. 62

Rear: check shoes wear (➤ P. 68) and freeplay, adjust if necessary. ➤ P. 66

- Lights and horn-Check that lights, indicators and horn function properly.
  - Clutch-Check operation; Adjust freeplay if necessary. ➤ P. 76
  - Wheels and tyres-Check condition, air pressure and adjust if necessary. ➤ P. 48
